Please arrive about 10 minutes before the service is to begin

Check in with the Deacon of the Month

After the prelude (opening music), go to the pulpit and begin your welcome with these words:

Good Morning! Whatever has brought you to this place at this time,

We welcome you, and hope that this hour we spend together in worship and prayer will refresh and renew you for the week ahead.

We are happy you have joined us this morning.

Here you may offer two or three sentences about why this faith community is important in your life or you may choose to use any one of the statements on the reverse side of this sheet.

Conclude with: **The Lord be with you,** (to which the congregation will answer, “And also with you.”)

The bell will be rung at the end of the work of the people and before the choir “introit”.
